

St. John the Evangelist School Dress Code

General Appearance

For all Students:

- Students must be well groomed at all times. In addition, clothes must not be tattered, frayed or show severe signs of wear and tear.
- Girls may wear one single post or stud earring per ear.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- Students may wear one necklace. Necklace may be worn on outside of clothes only if the necklace has a cross or religious emblem on it.
- Students may wear one bracelet per wrist.
- Hats or sunglasses may not be worn inside the school buildings.
- Student's hair must be a natural hair color.
- Hair accessories should be color-coordinated with the uniform (red, navy, white, brown, or black).

***All sweatshirts/hoodies and fleece outerwear worn on the school grounds must have the Saint John's Logo on it.**

St. John's sweatshirts/hoodies and fleece can be purchased at the school office. Middle school students may purchase St. John sweatshirts at MI sports as well.

It is unacceptable to come to school with:

- Tattered, frayed, ripped or soiled clothing
- Clothes that are too small for the student – skin tight clothes or pants too short
- Tattoos or artificial skin markings
- Excessive make-up
- Multiple necklaces or bracelets
- Ankle bracelets
- Artificial nails
- Colored nail polish
- Artificial hair braids/hair pieces
- Unnatural hair color
- Sweat shirts/hoodies with another Logo on them.

Students will be told when their clothing or appearance is unacceptable and will be given a notice of disciplinary action. Parents will be notified if the problem persists. It is important for both the students and parents to observe the dress code.

K – 5 th	Navy tie	Pre-tied or clip-on
K – 5 th	Socks	***White or navy <u>crew socks</u> only
K – 5 th	Shoes	Brown or black dress shoes with leather or leather like uppers (no tennis shoes or tennis like shoes)
K – 5 th	Belt (optional)	Plain black or brown with plain buckle
K – 5 th	***Primary red sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over oxford shirt and tie
K – 5 th	***Primary red Cardigan(optional)	To be worn over oxford shirt and tie

6 th - 8 th	Khaki twill pants (no shorts anytime for mass)	Pleat or flat front, slit pockets, straight leg, length must be at or below the ankle, must sit at the waist. No cargo pants.
6 th - 8 th	White Oxford Shirt	Short or long sleeve, button down collar
6 th - 8 th	Navy or ***Hamilton Plaid Tie	
6 th - 8 th	Socks	***Must be white or navy <u>crew socks</u>
6 th - 8 th	Shoes	Brown or black dress shoes with leather or leather like uppers (no tennis shoes or tennis like shoes)
6 th - 8 th	Belt (required)	Plain black or brown with plain buckle
6 th - 8 th	***Navy sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over oxford shirt and tie
6 th - 8 th	***Navy Cardigan (optional)	To be worn over oxford shirt and tie

*Only plain white (no designs or writing) short sleeve/sleeveless t-shirts can be worn under oxfords

*Shirts must be tucked in

*No sweatshirts/hoodies worn during mass

*Boys may take off tie and change into tennis shoes after mass

**Pants and white oxford shirts may be purchased at any store and be of any brand as long as they fit description above.

***Sweater vests and cardigan must be purchased through authorized uniform retailers.**

****Note: Whenever Mass falls on a day other than Friday, mass uniforms will be required instead of gym uniforms (mass uniform “trumps” any uniform).**

Grade	Item	Description
K – 5 th	***White Peter Pan Blouse	Plain or lace collar, short or long sleeve
K – 5 th	***Navy Cross tie	
K – 5 th	Hamilton plaid v-neck or scoop neck jumper, 3 tab pleated skort or pleated skirt	Must sit at waist level, length must be between knee and fingertip length *If skirt or jumper worn, bike or cotton gym shorts in navy, red or black must be worn. Shorts must be shorter than the skirt hemline, and cannot be visible below the skirt when standing or sitting.
K – 5 th	Socks	***White knee-highs or white tights only (calves must be covered). No leg warmers or leggings allowed
K – 5 th	Shoes	Plain black or brown dress shoes with leather or leather like uppers must be closed toes and closed heels (no sandals). Heels must be no more than 1 inch high
K – 5 th	***Primary red sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over blouse
K – 5 th	***Primary red cardigan (optional)	To be worn over blouse

6th–8th	***White Peter Pan Blouse	Plain or lace collar, short or long sleeve
6 th –8 th	***Navy or Hamilton Plaid Cross tie or *regular tie	
6 th –8 th	Hamilton plaid or ***Khaki jumper, 3 tab skort or pleated skirt	Must sit at waist level, length must be between knee and fingertip length *If skirt or jumper worn, bike or cotton gym shorts in navy, red or black must be worn. Shorts must be shorter than the skirt hemline, and cannot be visible below the skirt when standing or sitting.
6 th –8 th	Socks	***White knee-highs or white tights or nude pantyhose only (calves must be covered). No leg warmers, leggings, or footless tights allowed.
6 th –8 th	Shoes	Plain black or brown dress shoes with leather or leather like uppers must be closed toes and closed heels (no sandals). Heels must be no more than 1 inch high
6 th -8 th	***Navy sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over blouse
6 th -8 th	***Navy cardigan (optional)	To be worn over blouse

*The only thing that can be worn underneath blouse is a plain (no designs or writing) short sleeve/sleeveless white t-shirts or camisole.

*Girls may take off tie and change into tennis shoes after mass.

Regular School Uniforms

BOYS *new items for 2009**

Grade	Item	Description
K – 5 th	Navy Twill Pants or Shorts	Pleat or flat front, slit pockets, straight leg, length must be at or below the ankle, must sit at the waist. No Cargo Pants. Shorts may <u>only</u> be worn from March 15th through Nov. 15th. Short length must fall between the knee and fingertip length
K – 5 th	Primary red or white Polo shirt with school logo	Short or long sleeve. Shirts must be tucked in.
K – 5 th	Socks	***White or navy socks only. Must sit above the ankle
K – 5 th	Shoes	Tennis shoes or other non-scuffing shoes. Shoes with laces must be tied. Shoes without a back support or with open toes will not be allowed.
K – 5 th	Belt (optional)	Plain black or brown with plain buckle
K – 5 th	***Red sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over polo shirt
K-5 th	***Navy, red or white cardigan (optional)	To be worn over polo shirt
6th - 8th	Khaki twill pants or shorts	Pleat or flat front, slit pockets, straight leg, length must be at or below the ankle, must sit at the waist. No cargo pants. Shorts may only be worn after March 15th through Nov. 15th. Short length must fall between the knee and fingertip length.
6 th - 8 th	Primary red, ***navy or white Polo shirt with school logo	Short or long sleeve. Shirts must be tucked in.
6 th - 8 th	Socks	Must be white or navy that *** <i>sit above the ankle</i>
6 th - 8 th	Shoes	Tennis shoes or other non-scuffing shoes. Shoes with laces must be tied. Shoes without a back support or with open toes will not be allowed.
6 th - 8 th	Belt (required)	Plain black or brown with plain buckle
6 th - 8 th	***Navy sweater vest (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over polo shirt
6 th – 8 th	***Navy, red or white cardigan (optional)	To be worn over polo shirt

*No layering of shirts. Only plain white (no designs or writing) short sleeve/sleeveless t-shirts may be worn under polo shirts.

*No underwear can be seen above the pant line

*Pants and shorts may be of any brand as long as they fit description above

*Sweater vests and cardigans must be purchased at authorized uniform retailers

*Please note that the white polo will eventually be phased out for all grades. Please note this when buying polo's. It would be best to purchase red.

Grade	Item	Description
K – 5 th	Navy Twill pants/shorts or 3 tab skorts	Flat front or pleated, straight legged. Pants must sit at waist level and length must be below the ankle. Shorts may only be worn after March 15th through Nov. 15th. Short/skort length must fall between the knee and fingertip length
K – 5 th	Hamilton plaid skorts/skirts/jumpers	Must sit at waist level, length must be between knee and fingertip length *If skirt or jumper worn, bike or cotton gym shorts in navy, red or black must be worn
K – 5 th	Primary red or white Polo with school logo	Short or long sleeve. Shirts must be tucked in
K – 5 th	Socks	***White, red, or navy socks <u>must sit above the ankle.</u>
K – 5 th	Shoes	Tennis shoes or other shoes with a non-scuffing sole. Shoes with laces must be tied. Shoes without a back support or with open toes are not allowed. Sandals with a back heel support are allowed with socks. Heels may not be more than 1 inch high.
K – 5 th	***Red sweater vests (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over polo shirt
K – 5 th	***Navy, red or white cardigan (optional)	To be worn over polo shirt
6th–8th	***Khaki twill pants/shorts, 3 tab skort or pleated skirt	Flat front or pleated, straight legged. Pants must sit at waist level and length must be below the ankle. Shorts/skorts or skirts length must be between knee and fingertip length. Shorts may only be worn after March 15th through Nov. 15th.
6 th –8 th	Hamilton plaid jumper, skort or skirt	Must sit at waist level, length must be between knee and fingertip length *If skirt or jumper worn, bike or cotton gym shorts in navy, red or black must be worn.
6 th –8 th	Primary red, ***navy or white Polo shirt with school logo	Short or long sleeve. Shirts must be tucked in.
6 th –8 th	Socks	White, red or navy socks <u>that sit above the ankle</u> , knee-highs or tights/nylons. NO leggings. NO leg warmers. NO footies.
6 th –8 th	Shoes	Tennis shoes or other shoes with a non-scuffing sole. Shoes with laces must be tied. Shoes without a back support or with open toes are not allowed. Sandals with a back heel support are allowed with socks/tights. Heels may not be more than 1 inch high.
6 th –8 th	***Navy sweater vests (optional)	4 button-up or pullover. To be worn over polo shirt
6 th –8 th	***Red, navy or white cardigan (optional)	To be worn over polo shirt

*No layering of shirts. Only plain white (no designs or writing) short sleeve/sleeveless t-shirts may be worn under polo shirts.

*No underwear can be seen above pant line.

Gym Uniforms

Girls and Boys *new items for 2009**

Grade	Item	Description
K – 5 th	Navy sweat pants or shorts	Must be plain cotton or cotton/blend, <u>no brand logos</u> . No nylon sweatpants. Nylon shorts OK. No “rolling” of waistband. Shorts can be worn from March 15 th and through Nov. 15 th . Short length must fall between the knee and the fingertip length.
K- 5 th	Red or gray t-shirts with School Logo	Short or ***long sleeve. Must be tucked in.
K - 5 th	Tennis shoes	Non-scuffing
K – 5 th	NOTE	On gym days, students wear their gym uniform all day except on mass days. If gym shorts worn under sweatpants, sweatpants may be removed for gym class only.

6 th – 8 th	Navy sweat pants or shorts	<u>No brand logos</u> , no “rolling” of waistbands, short length must fall between the knee and fingertip length. No nylon sweatpants. Nylon shorts OK.
6 th – 8 th	Red or gray t-shirts with school Logo	Short or ***long sleeve. Must be tucked in.
6 th – 8 th	Tennis shoes	Non-scuffing
6 th – 8 th	NOTE	Middle schoolers must change into their gym uniforms for gym class, then must change out of their gym uniform before returning to class.

*Sweat pants or shorts can be purchased anywhere as long as they fit description above.

*School logo t-shirts can be purchased only at All School Uniforms or The Dress Code Shoppe

Miscellaneous Dress code information:

Scouts: Boys and girls may wear Scout or Campfire uniforms on their regularly scheduled meeting days.

Casual/Dress Down days: These day fall on early release days, special “fundraiser” days or other special days announced by the principal. Elementary students may wear blue jeans or blue jean shorts/capris (from March 15th – November 15th) with a uniform shirt. Middle school students may wear blue

jeans or blue jean shorts/capris (from March 15th – November 15th) with a uniform shirt, school spirit shirt or Walk-a-thon shirt.

*Allowing middle school students the option of a spirit shirt was decided to give the middle school students some special privileges and sets them apart from the elementary students.

Full Dress Down Day: Occurs rarely, usually set by the principal as a reward. Any clothing is allowed on this day that is appropriate for St. John's school.

Makeup: Permitted only in 6-8th grade. Light foundation, clear lip-gloss. Clear nail polish. If excess makeup noted, girls may be asked to remove makeup at school.

Field Trips: The teacher leading the field trip will decide which uniforms will be appropriate for each field trip.

Winter Months: From November 15th – March 15th, no shorts are allowed. For girls during this time, if skirts, skorts or jumpers are worn, calves must be covered with knee high socks, tights or nylons for middle school kids.
